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# **Choosing Subjects**

#### You Should:

- Choose subjects you enjoy and are good at.
- Discuss selection with your teachers and parents for their recommendations.
- Focus on your goals for senior and post-school.
- Use the work you have been doing in Access.
- Talk to the Guidance Officer, your Access Teacher, Leaders of Learning, or Deputy Principal.
  You Shouldn't:
- Choose subjects you think will be easy.
- Choose subjects just because your friends are doing them.
- Choose subjects you don't really like or have struggled with in the past



#### Important Points...

- ALL subjects are academically challenging there are no easy subjects.
- Choose subjects very carefully as once you have selected your subjects, you cannot change them.
- In Year 10 all subjects (including electives) will be studied for a full year.



### **Subject Selections**

- Students will be required to select eight subjects and two back up subjects in case your first choices are unavailable.
- Students must choose English.
- Students must choose between the extension and core subjects for Mathematics, History and Science.
- Spanish Immersion students are required to select History and Maths Immersion



### **HPE Subjects**

- Students must select either Health and Physical Education, Physical Education Extension, HPE Immersion (Spanish Immersion Students) or Football Academy (Football Academy Students).
- Health Education Extension is an additional elective.

 Your selections need to be submitted by Friday 20 August or you will most likely not get your top choices.


You need to:

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
### **Specific Subject Information**

### Tracking Student Progress
