## Under this agreement for 2016

Murrumba State Secondary College will receive

### This funding will be used to

#### Reading

- Increase the percentage of students meeting National Minimum Standard (NMS) in Year 7&9 NAPLAN Reading to 100%.
- Increase the percentage of students achieving NAPLAN U2B in 2016 Year 7 & 9 Reading to 25% and to 30% for NAPLAN Reading Year 9 2018 (for Year 7 2016 cohort)
- Increase the engagement with and appreciation of reading reflected in survey results
- Increase the average percentile score by at least 10% for Year 7 & 8 PAT Reading over the twelve month period to December 2016

#### Numeracy

- Increase the percentage of students meeting National Minimum Standard (NMS) in Year 7&9 NAPLAN Numeracy to 100%.
- Increase the percentage of students achieving NAPLAN U2B in 2016 Year 7 & 9 Numeracy to 25% and to 30% for NAPLAN Numeracy Year 9 2018 (for Year 7 2016 cohort)
- Increase the average percentile score by at least 10% for Year 7 & 8 PAT Mathematics over the twelve month period to December 2016.

#### Writing

- Increase the percentage of students meeting National Minimum Standard (NMS) in Year 7&9 NAPLAN Numeracy to 100%.
- Increase the percentage of students achieving NAPLAN U2B in 2016 Year 7 & 9 Writing to 20% and to 25% for NAPLAN Writing Year 9 2018 (for Year 7 2016 cohort)
- Increase the average percentile score by at least 10% for Year 7 & 8 PAT eWriting over the twelve month period to December 2016

### Our initiatives include

#### Reading

- Identify and implement strategies and common language across three identified key program domains in target incubation groups
- Engage staff, students and the college community in the explicit teaching of strategies to enhance engagement with reading
- Engage parents in education and support around student reading for pleasure
- Align College reading program strategies where appropriate with primary feeder schools
- Enhance the collection of and engagement with student performance data pertaining to reading
- Provide enhanced staff support and monitoring of progress

## Numeracy

- Embed Automaticity focused numeracy starters across the College in all Year 7-10 classes
- Streamline testing and individual targets for students
- Target strategies and groupings for Numeracy lessons based on performance data
- Embed Whole College Numeracy Plan 2015-2018 and Numeracy indicators
- Dedicated Numeracy Coach position developing staff capability, providing feedback and driving QA

## Writing


- Extend Identified school-wide focus (7 Steps to Writing) implementation to include whole of Junior Secondary focus
- Develop staff understanding; chunking, repetition, muscle memory, Brainstorm, consistency.
- Master Teacher and Literacy Coaches developing staff capability, providing feedback and driving QA
