Application process:

- 1. Request an application form either in person or via below email and submit with supporting documents by 30th July.
- Initial candidates will be notified and required to attend an interview which will include a 200 - 250 word essay on "Why I wish to be a member of The Academy of Entrepreneurship and Innovation".
- 3. Parent/caregiver and student notified of admission decision.
- 4. Diploma of Business subject is selected through Year 10 SET process.

What is the Academy of Entrepreneurship and Innovation?
