- Increase the percentage of students achieving A -C levels of achievement and the percentage of students achieving A - B levels aligned to Annual Implementation Plan (AIP) and whole school data plan targets and measures.
- Increase student engagement and wellbeing through building and strengthening our student's sense of belonging, resulting in improved attendance rates.
- Review and enhance the systems and processes to identify student learning and performance needs for targeted resourcing for appropriate intervention strategies.
- Build an expert teaching team to cater for the learning needs of all students.
- Enhance our collaboration and transition programs with our feeder primary schools.

- Building the data literacy capability of staff and embedding structures to facilitate cyclical engagement with student performance data to inform planning a practice.
- Continuing to embed student case management processes as our "way of working" across the College.
- Reviewing and refining targeted intervention programs for students.

- Building teacher capability through our collegial engagement framework which includes collaboration, peer observation, coaching and feedback.
