- Continue to engage staff, students and the College community in the explicit teaching of the *Murrumba Reading for Life, Writing for Life, and Problem Solving for Life* initiatives, to build common language and enhance comprehension at all levels of proficiency
- Build staff data literacy capabilities, and embed structures to facilitate cyclical engagement with student performance data to inform planning and practice
- Enhance Quality Learning Coach (QLC) roles to align practice and target capability development
- Embed College Wellbeing Framework
