

Industry Liaison Officer (ILO)

The Industry Liaison Officer (ILO) works closely with students in Years 10 to 12, providing personalised support to help them explore and pursue vocational education and employment opportunities. The ILO offers support to students, ensuring they are well-informed about available pathways.

Support provided includes:

- Work Experience Coordination
- Organising meaningful work experience placements aligned with student interests and career goals. Preparation of agreements and organisation of site visits.
- School-Based Traineeships & Apprenticeships
- Support with researching, applying for, and securing school-based training opportunities.
- Vocational Education & Training (VET)
- Guidance on enrolling in VET courses through TAFE and other Registered Training Organisations (RTOs).
- Full-Time Apprenticeship Applications
- Help with navigating and completing applications for fulltime apprenticeships after school.
- Work Readiness Preparation
- Assistance with submitting resumes and cover letters and giving guidance on developing interview skills.
